The first quarter meeting of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the University was held on 24.03.2022. The members discussed the following Agenda and resolved as follows:

Item No. 1: To discuss the revision of syllabi from the Academic Year 2022-23.

Members were informed about revision of Syllabi for Under Graduate Programs in the University from the Academic Year 2022-23. It was decided to hold the Board of Studies (BoS) meetings for the faculties of Photography, Facilities & Services Planning (FSP) and Animation before preparing the draft syllabus by the departments.

It was decided to explore the possibilities of changing the title of the course of Facilities & Services Planning (FSP) as the admissions into the course are dropping every year.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor suggested to conduct an "Open Day" on First Saturday of May, 2022 i.e. 07.05.2022 with the participation of all the Departments in the University by inviting prospective students, organizations of Building Industry, concerned departments of the State Government and Civil Society Organizations. It was also decided to install Suggestion Boxes in every department of the University.

Item No. 2: To discuss the subject of Alumni connect with the University.

It was decided to strengthen the Alumni Committee of the University by including one faculty member from each department, so as to work towards formation of Alumni Association for the University.

It was decided to collect Rs. 100/- (Rupees: One Hundred only) from both Undergraduate and Post-graduate students when they complete their programs and carry out an exit Survey, while they are passing out in order to maintain the details of the fresh graduates of the University for any further reference.

Item No. 3: To discuss the matter related to Students magazine.

It was decided to launch a student magazine for the University Colleges, by forming a Committee comprising of one faculty member from each department from both the Colleges as Coordinators for the Magazine Committee.

It was also decided to identify faculty coordinators at department level to act as a liason between the students and placement cell and also establish a placement cell for the University.

Item No. 4: To discuss about starting a peer reviewed panel for the University.

The Director of Research & Development Cell of the University was requested to explore the possibilities and modalities for launching a Peer reviewed Journal for the University and also to conduct a workshop on Scientific Research paper writing for the benefit of teaching faculty members.

Item No. 5: To discuss about formation of Student Clubs.

It was also resolved to form student clubs at University level, such as Heritage Club, Music Club, Film Screening Club, etc. Both the Principals of the University Colleges were asked to finalize the kind and quantum of clubs in the University at the earliest.

Important Note: The Principals of JNAFAU School of Planning and Architecture & JNAFAU College of Fine Arts are requested to take necessary action as per the above resolutions at the earliest possible.
