Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

- Paper presented in Seminars/ Conferences and also published as full paper in Conference proceedings will be counted only once.
- Similarly, paper presented if part of edited book then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.

- *For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b). Policy Document and 6. Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
- Along with the duly filled table, please attach proofs wherever necessary and certify that the information provided is correct as per documents enclosed.

A teacher shall be promoted if;

- (i) The teacher gets a 'satisfactory' or 'good' grade in the annual performance assessment reports of at least four of the last five years of the assessment period,(as prescribed in Appendix II, Table1) and;
- (ii) The promotion is recommended by the Screening-cum-evaluation committee.

I. Assistant Professor (Selection Grade/AcademicLevel12) to Associate Professor(AcademicLevel 13A)

- 1) Assistant Professor who has completed three years of service in Academic Level 12/Selection grade.
- 2) A Ph.D Degree in the subject concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
- 3) Any one of the following during last three years: completed one course/programme from amongst the categories of Refresher Courses /Research Methodology Workshops /Syllabus Up-gradation Workshop/Teaching-Learning-Evaluation Technology Programme/ Faculty Development Programme of atleast two weeks (ten days) duration (or completed two courses of at least one week (five days) duration in lieu of every single course / programme of at least two weeks (ten days) duration); or completed one MOOCs course (with e-certification); or contribution towards the development of e-content in 4-quadrant (at least one quadrant) minimum of 10 modules of a course/contribution towards development of at least 10modulesofMOOCs course/contribution towards conduct of a MOOCs course during the period of assessment.
- 4) A minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals out of which three research papers should have been published during the assessment period.
- 5) Evidence of having guided atleast one Ph.D.candidate.

CAS Promotion Criteria:

A teacher shall be promoted if;

(i) He/she gets a 'satisfactory' or 'good' grade in the annual performance assessment reports of at least two of the last three years of the assessment period as specified in Appendix II, Table 1, and has a research score of at least70 as per Appendix II, Table 2.

(ii) The promotion is recommended by a selection committee constituted in accordance with these Regulations.

II. Associate Professor (Academic Level 13A) to Professor (Academic Level 14) Eligibility:

- 1) An Associate Professor who has completed three years of service in Academic Level13A.
- 2) A Ph.D degree in the subject concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
- A minimum of ten research publications in the peer- reviewed or UGC-listed journals out of which three research papers should have been published during the assessment period.
- 4) Evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.
- 5) A minimum of 110 Research Score as per Appendix II, Table2.

CAS Promotion Criteria:

A teacher shall be promoted if;

- (i) He/she gets 'satisfactory' or' good' grade in the annual performance assessment reports of at least two of the last three years of the assessment period, as perAppendixII,Table1,andatleast110researchscore,asperAppendixII,Table2.
- (ii) The promotion is recommended by a selection committee constituted in accordance with these Regulations.

III. Professor (AcademicLevel14) to Senior Professor (AcademicLevel15)

A Professor can be promoted to the post of Senior Professor under the CAS. The promotion shall be based on academic achievement, favorable review from three eminent subject experts who are not of the rank lower than the rank of a Senior Professor or a Professor having at least ten years' of experience. The selection shall be based on 10 best publications during the last 10 years and interaction with a Selection Committee constituted inaccordance with these Regulations.

Eligibility:

- (i) Ten years' experience as a Professor.
- (ii) Aminimumoftenpublicationsinthepeer-reviewedorUGC-listedjournalsandPh.D.degreehasbeensuccessfullyawardedtotwocandidatesunderhis/her supervisionduringthe assessment period.
